Please note:

- For Design Technology we accept applications from individuals specialising in a particular discipline (e.g. food technology, resistant materials, engineering etc.) but training and placements will offer experience in a variety of topics, as most DT teachers will cover more than one element of Design and Technology.
- For Modern Languages we offer a combination of French and Spanish and German, candidates will complete training and classroom experience in two of the three languages. Other languages may be considered but the vast majority of secondary schools in Oxfordshire will only teach two or three of the languages listed.
- For PE programmes, we are restricted to a very limited number of places, we do also offer combined PE programmes which enable us to offer additional places for those with an A level grade C or above in maths, a science, history, geography, English or a language – these are referred to as the ‘PE with EBacc’ scheme.
- Social Sciences usually refers to a programme which combines psychology and sociology, other areas such as political science and anthropology may be covered within the curriculum but are less commonly offered in schools as a standalone subject, so are not generally a large part of the training or teaching experience.
